It is ORDERED and DIRECTED that the notice as set forth in the petition is sufficient.

It is FURTHER ORDERED and DECREED that the Estate of AAA, Deceased, be awarded as follows:

1. Costs of Administration, including filing fees to the Register of Wills and an attorney's fee of \$lll for services rendered in connection with the preparation of this petition before the Court to H. Amos Goodall, Jr.
2. All claims against the decedent as well as costs incurred in connection with the administration of the decedent's assets including the additional fees of Petitioner's attorney and other professionals whose services are necessary or appropriate in the administration of this estate, in accordance with the classification and order of payment as provided in 20 Pa.C.S.A. §3392.
3. Balance to CCC.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that CCC be and is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary or appropriate to the liquidation of the decedent's assets. This decree shall constitute sufficient authority to all transfer agents, registrars and others dealing with the property of the Estate of AAA to recognize CCC as entitled to receive the property to be distributed without administration and shall in all respects have the same effect as a decree of distribution after an accounting by a personal representative. CCC shall be authorized to act in the name of the decedent in preparing tax returns and

similar documents.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that any exceptions to this decree must be filed within ten (10) days after the date hereof.
